History of the College

Nandyal is one of the important towns in Rayalaseema region. This town is an abode of Nine Nandis and attained significance since ancient times. People from all over the country visit this town to reach Mahanandi where one of the prominent nandis is located. During the past two decades Nandyal witnessed rapid growth in the field of education, agriculture and industry.

In order to provide higher education to the people of this place and adjoining villages a few philanthropists like Sri. Pasapula Subbarayudu Chetty and Kasetty Venkata Subbaiah Chetty came forward with donations and established this College in the year 1967. In the beginning Pre-University Courses like M.P.C, Bi.P.C. C.E.C, H.E.C, and U.G Courses like B.A, B.Com, & B.Sc., were offered. This college is named after Sri Pasapula Venkata Subbaiah Chetty and Kasetty Venkata Subbaiah Chetty in due acknowledgment of their significant donations.

Due to lack of accommodation, this institution was housed in E.S.C. Govt. Polytechnic, Nandyal and in the year 1979 it was completely shifted to its own buildings near Bommalasathram. The college building was inaugurated by late Sri Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy, the President of India.

Since 1969 the college has been offering two year Intermediate Courses up to 1995-96 along with B.Sc. (M.P.C & B.Z.C.), B.A. & B.Com., Courses in Telugu Medium only. But from the academic year 1986-87, The College has been offering B.S.C., (M.P.E). Course in English Medium only. one batch of B.Com., in English Medium was offered in this college during the academic year 1971-74. But the college offering B.Sc(M.P.Cs) from the academic year 2003-04,B.Sc. (M.E.Cs) from the academic year 2005-06,B.Com(CA) from the academic year 2008-09 and B.A(Computers) from the academic year 2009-10 in English Medium . P.G course in Mathematics was started in 2003, and M.A(English),M.Sc.,(Physics) were started in 2005.M.Sc(Chemistry) was started in2009-10.One N.C.C unit with a regular officer, Two N.S.S units with Two programme officers are also functioning in the college. V. Code of Conduct for Students.

- 1. Every Student must come to the college regularly. As a mark of courtesy students shall greet the members of the teaching staff at their first meeting of the day outside the class room
- 2. No student will be permitted to enter the classes after the stroke of the third bell.
- 3. Attendance will be given only if they are in the classes by the time the teacher takes the roll call.

- 6. Every student to whom books, Laboratory apparatus or other property of the college are entrusted will be held responsible for their preservation in good condition and in the event of their being lost or damaged will be required to replace them or repay the cost.
- 7. Any student breaking or damaging any college property will be required to pay the cost of the damaged in addition to that he/she will be punished.

XIII. Library and Reading Room


