3 4 2 Extension/Outreach Program Reports

- 1. War on Mosquitoes- On the occasion of World Mosquito Control Day, the students and staff conducted a rally on 24-09-2016 to make the people aware of affects of mosquitoes. The public are educated on preventive measures to control spreading of diseases like malaria, Dengue, etc., by distributing pamphlets. The students also educated the villagers in their respective villages. In this rally 215 students and 19 staff members participated in the Rally.
- 2. Students participated in the Blood Donation camp organized by Red Ribbon Club in association with Red Cross Society. This program will help the needy people in emergency and Trauma. Further it cultivates a habit of saving the lives of the people in need. 46 Students and 2 staff members donated blood in this program.
- 3. The staff and students conducted Nava Nirmana Diksha in adopted village, Chapirevula. This program is an initiative of Government of Andhra Pradesh. This was conducted for one week and the villagers were made aware of various schemes and programs introduced by the Government in Education, Agriculture, Health, Water harvesting, etc. Each day, the Officers corresponding Government Departments of the participated along with the Staff and Students of the college.
- 4. The students and the Staff along with NCC and NSS units conducted a rally on the awareness on HIV and AIDS on the occasion of *World AIDS Day*. In this 241 students and 22 staff members participated in this rally.
- 5. On the occasion of International Yoga Day, the Staff and the Students conducted a Rally in Nandyal to make the people aware of the importance of Yoga in keeping the good health in present days' stressful life.

- 6. In order to cultivate social responsibility and Service orientation among the students, the Department of physics chalked out a Program named *Fist of Rice*. In this program, the students are asked to get a fist of rice from their home and is collected for 3 days. Thus collected rice and the donations received from the staff is donated to St. Luke's Blind School, Nandyal where 26 Blind students are studying staying in the Hostel.. In this program 195kg rice and 20 kg Red gram have been donated.
- 7. The program Janma Bhumi-maa vuuru is an initiative of Government of Andhra Pradesh in which all Higher Educational Institutions are involved to take part. In this program, under supervision of the ECO Club, the students and the staff went to the adopted village, Chapirevula and participated in clean and green activity in the village and educated the villagers on health and hygiene, ODF, Child marriages, etc.
- 8. NSS unit conducted a Rally on Anti Leprosy Day to educate consequences of leprosy to the public and how it can be eradicated through placards. The NSS volunteers also explained how leprosy patients are to be treated.
- 9. The students and the staff conducted awareness Rally on the harmful effects of using plastic near Nandyal Railway station. The customers of road-side hotels and Tea shops were explained about the harmful effects of using plastic covers used for packing food and paper cups used for taking tea.
- 10. The NSS Volunteers participated in the awareness program on Covid Vaccination in the adopted village, Chapirevula. During covid pandemic, people were very panic and even afraid of taking the Vaccine. Our college NSS volunteers educated the villagers to take vaccination.
- 11. The NSS Volunteers participated in the awareness program on measures to control of Covid in the adopted village, Chapirevula. During covid pandemic, NSS volunteers distributed Masks to the villagers in the Village.
- 12. During lockdown period, NSS volunteers distributed Food pockets to the villagers in the adopted village, Chapirevula. The NSS Volunteers participated in the awareness program on the measures to control of the spread of Covid.

- 13. Students participated in the Blood Donation camp organized by Red Ribbon Club in association with Red Cross Society. This program will help the needy people in emergency and Trauma. Further it cultivates a habit of saving the lives of the people in need. 32 Students and 3 staff members donated blood in this program.
- 14. The RRC and ECO club of the College along with the students and the Staff conducted a rally on the awareness on HIV and AIDS on the occasion of *World AIDS Day*. In this 164 students and 19 staff members participated in this rally.
- 15. The NSS Volunteers participated in the awareness program on Swachha Bharath, Child Marriages, Nutrition and hygiene in Venkateswarapuram Village, Nandyal Mandal. In this program, the students cleaned High School premises in the village and educated the villagers on malnutrition of children and hygiene.
- 16. The NSS Volunteers participated in the awareness program on Clean and Green, Child Marriages, Nutrition and Health & Hygiene in the adapted village Chapirevula, Nandyal Mandal. In this program, the students cleaned School and Hospital premises in the village and educated the villagers on malnutrition of children and hygiene.
- 17. The staff and the students participated in the 75 years of Independence, *Azadi ka Amrith Mahotsav* which is a Government of India initiative. In this program, the students carried Indian flags and participated in the rally in Nandyal Town chanting the patriotic slogans like *Bharat maatha Ki Jai*.
