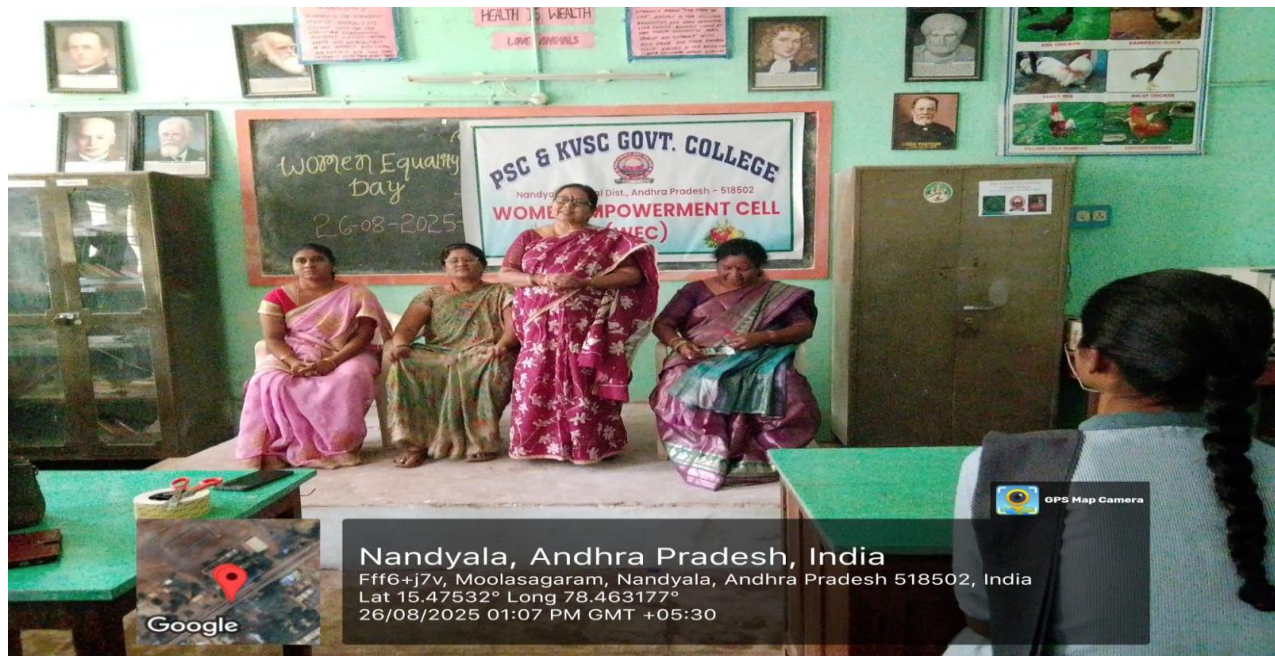
1. To create awareness on women's equality, rights, and empowerment among students on Women Equality Day.

2. The programme promoted confidence, interaction, and women empowerment among participants.

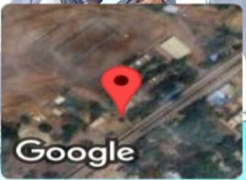
Brief Report
