Programme Objective: To create awareness about HIV/AIDS transmission, prevention, and responsible health practices.

World AIDS Day was observed on 01.12.2025 with great seriousness and purpose on our campus.

The programme was organized under the guidance of Dr. N. Shashikala, Principal of the college, with the active involvement of the staff and students. A total of 220 students and 25 staff members participated enthusiastically.

The main objective of the programme was to create awareness about HIV/AIDS — its modes of transmission, the importance of preventive measures, and the need to remove fear, stigma, and discrimination from society. Dr. Shashikala addressed the gathering and sensitized the students about the realities of AIDS, clearly explaining how it spreads and, more importantly, how it does **not** spread. She emphasized personal responsibility, safe practices, compassion toward affected individuals, and the importance of early testing and counseling. Her talk encouraged students to be informed, empathetic, and proactive ambassadors of awareness in their communities.

Following the awareness session, a rally was organized through the main areas of the town. Students and staff walked together holding placards and banners, raising meaningful slogans such as “*Know AIDS — No Fear,*” “*Awareness is Protection,*” and “*Stop Stigma, Support Life.*” The rally aimed to reach the public and remind everyone of their role in preventing the spread of HIV/AIDS.

Programme Outcome:

The programme successfully increased awareness among students about HIV/AIDS and inspired them to share accurate information with others. Participants gained clarity on prevention, respect for those affected, and the importance of responsible health practices. The rally created visibility in the community and helped spread a positive message of awareness, care, and social responsibility.

Programme Outcome:

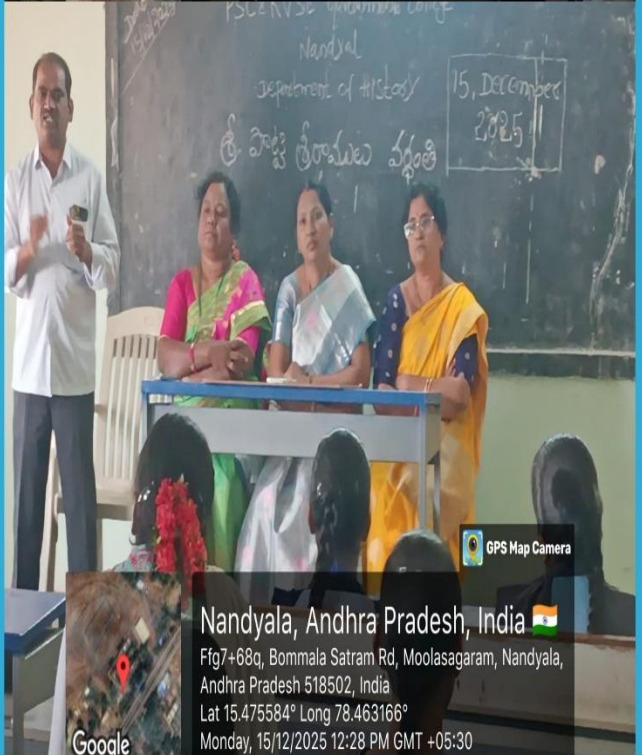

Programme Objective:

Programme Description:

Dr. Shashikala highlighted the growing importance of MOOCs and online certification in enhancing professional competence. She emphasized that NPTEL and SWAYAM, initiated by the Government of India, provide high-quality academic content from IITs, IISc, and leading national institutions, accessible to all at minimal cost.

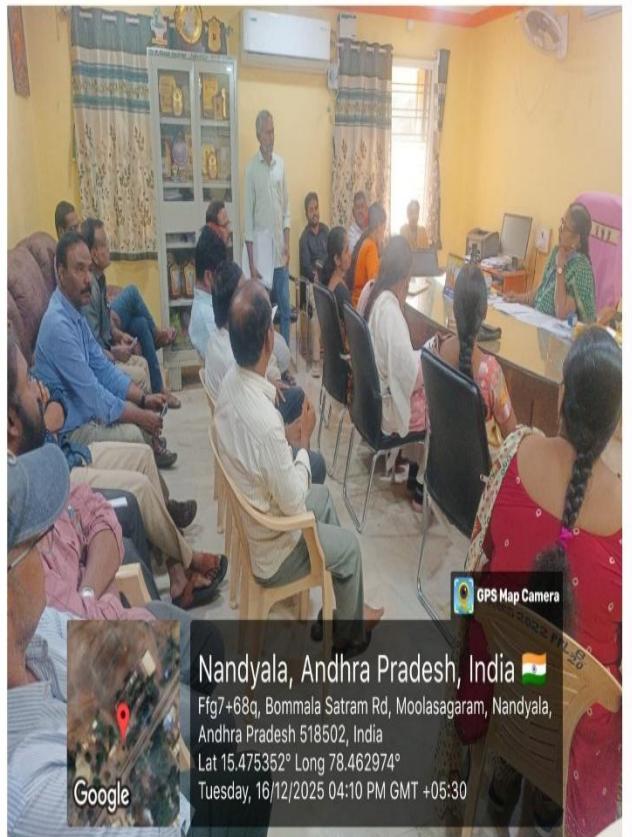
Faculty were briefed on:

- course selection strategies based on subject relevance
- registration procedures
- certification benefits for career advancement
- opportunities for blended learning and classroom enrichment
- mentoring students to enroll and complete courses successfully

The Principal encouraged every department to motivate students to register for at least one certificate course each semester. Faculty coordinators were identified to support the enrollment process and monitor student progress. Clarifications regarding credits, assessment patterns, and final examinations were also discussed.

Programme Outcome:

The meeting strengthened awareness about digital learning platforms and built confidence among faculty to actively participate in online certification initiatives. Teachers resolved to register for courses themselves, act as mentors for students, and integrate advanced topics from NPTEL/SWAYAM into teaching practices. As a result, the institution is moving toward a culture of continuous learning, improved academic quality, and national-level exposure for students and staff alike.





Theme: “Students should be rescued to overcome depression” — District Collector

The District Level Monitoring Committee (DLMC) meeting was organized to discuss student welfare, mental health support, and preventive measures against rising stress and suicidal tendencies among students. The meeting was convened at the Collectorate under the chairmanship of District Collector Smt. G. Rajakumari.

Objective of the programme:

To review student mental health challenges, strengthen support systems, and ensure coordinated action among departments to reduce depression and prevent suicides among students.

Programme Description

Addressing the committee, the Collector emphasized that every department — education, health, counseling, sports, and social welfare — must work with empathy and sensitivity toward students. She stressed that students often face pressure related to academics, examinations, future careers, and post-pandemic uncertainties, making supportive intervention essential.

She suggested:

- promoting sports and games to relieve stress
- regular counseling sessions in institutions
- strengthening parent–teacher–student communication
- early identification of at-risk students
- creating safe spaces where students can express concerns freely

The Collector reiterated that **no student should feel isolated**, and timely counseling can save lives. Our college Principal **Dr. N. Shashikala** actively participated in the deliberations, sharing insights on mentoring systems and counseling practices followed on campus. Faculty members from our college also attended, contributing valuable suggestions on academic support and emotional well-being initiatives.

Programme Outcome

The meeting reinforced multi-department coordination for student mental health care. Institutions resolved to conduct awareness programmes, encourage recreational and sports activities, identify stress factors early, and provide counseling support. The session strengthened commitment to building compassionate campuses where students feel supported, confident, and emotionally secure.

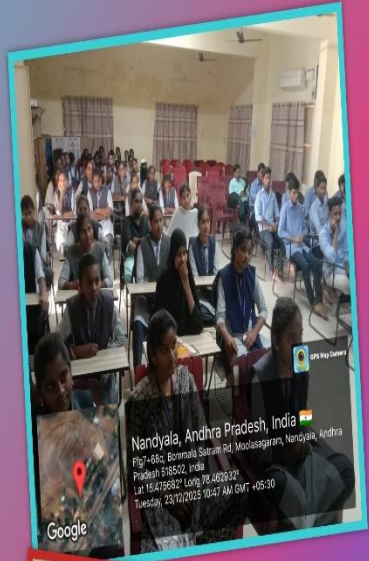

The Principal, **Dr. N. Shashikala**, motivated students to draw inspiration from these heroic stories and apply courage and determination in their lives.

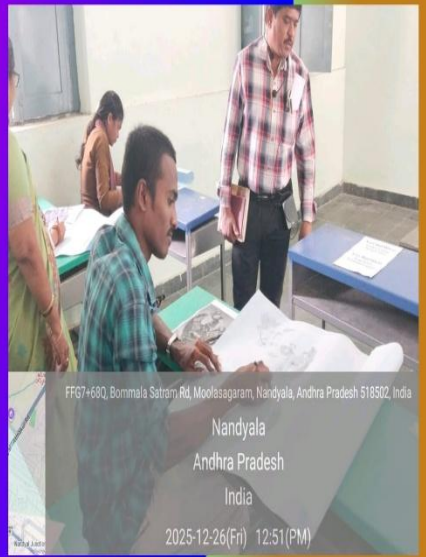
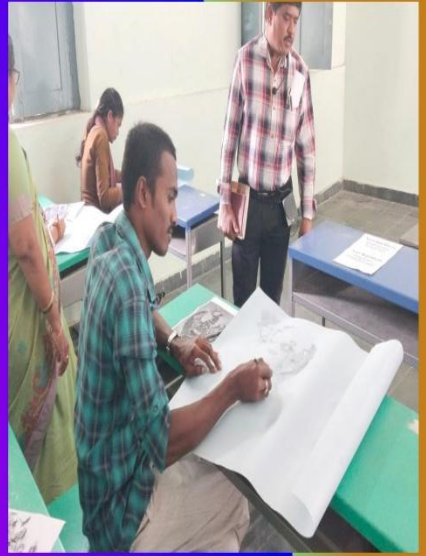
Smt. S. Parvathi spoke about character building and the need to preserve national values.
