Outcome of the Programme:

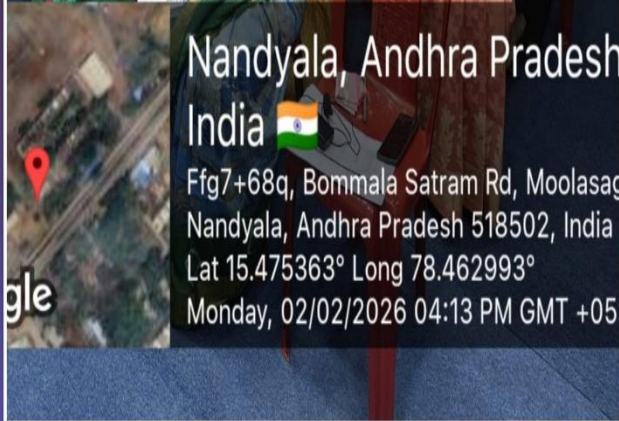

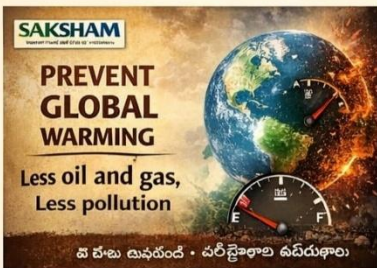
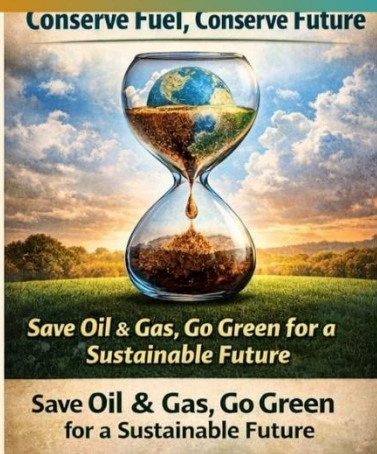
Date of the Activity: 13-02-2026
